SCONUL ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON MANUSCRIPTS

A seminar on the theme 'Late medieval liturgical manuscripts', held at King's College London, on 3 July 1986, was attended by about 60 people. Speakers were the Rev Dr David Tripp, 'History of the liturgy in the late Middle Ages', A J Piper, 'The structure of books for mass and office', Nicholas Rogers, 'English secular calendars of the 15th century', Dr David Hiley, 'Books for the choir', Janet Backhouse, 'The texts of Books of Hours', and Dr Ian Doyle, 'Vernacular texts in books of personal devotion'.

The Annual General Meeting of the Group will take place on 12 December 1986 at the British Library, 2 Sheraton Street, London W1. The theme of the meeting will be 'National Archives Policy'. Speakers will be Amanda Arrowsmith (County Archivist, Suffolk), Vic Gray (County Archivist, Essex), Penelope Bulloch (Librarian, Balliol College, Oxford), Michael Borrie (Department of Manuscripts, British Library), Peter Jones (Librarian, King's College, Cambridge).

A one-day seminar about English literary manuscripts and letters from the eighteenth to the twentieth century and location registers, will be held at the British Academy lecture theatre on 3 July 1987. Further details will be announced.

LECTURES

THE OXFORD SEMINAR ON THE HISTORY OF THE BOOK TO 1500

A conference was held at St Edmund Hall, Oxford, on 5-6 July 1986. Speakers included M Smith, T J Brown, A C de la Mare, L Armstrong, K Scott and J Hermans. A session was devoted to Muzerelle's Vocabulaire Codicologique. R Hamer spoke on problems of computerizing catalogue descriptions of western medieval manuscripts.

At a meeting at St John's on 14 September, M Parkes spoke on techniques of rapid writing, and T Webber on the manuscripts of Salisbury canons in the late 11th and early 12th century. On 14 December, L Brownrigg will talk on two 10th-century Canterbury scriptoria, P Robinson and J Goldfinch on problems of dating manuscripts and incunabula respectively. ACCESSIONS

The British Library

The Trustees of the Stefan Zweig Collection have presented to the Library their magnificent collection of some 180 musical and literary autograph manuscripts. A number of the music manuscripts, including works by Mozart, Bach, Beethoven and Brahms, were already held by the Library on loan. The music manuscripts include important pieces by Grieg, Offenbach, Debussy and Strauss; the most remarkable musical item is Mozart's 'Verzeichnüss [sic] aller meiner Werke', which the composer kept from February 1784 until his death in 1791. The collection is especially rich in French literary autographs and includes manuscripts by Balzac, Byron, Rilke, Nietzsche, Tolstoi and Dostoevsky.

Other notable recent acquisitions are two manuscript estate plans by Christopher Saxton, dated 1594 and 1602; the papers of Richard Graham, Viscount Preston, English envoy in Paris from 1682 to 1685 and later Secretary of State to James I

The Aslake World Map (British Library Add.MS.63841). The cover of the 1483-84 rental of the lands in Norfolk of Walter Aslake has turned out to be a fragment of the earliest known English medieval mappa mundi to show the influence of portolan charts, and dates from c 1325-75. It will be exhibited in the British Library (11 December 1986-1 March 1987) together with a fragment of a large decorated world map of the first half of the 13th century, which has recently come to light as the cover of a document in the duchy of Cornwall Office, and which will be on loan for the exhibition.

National Art Library, Victoria and Albert Museum

Letters from Sir Edwin Landseer and Sir Francis Grant, 1847-1874.

Letterbooks, diary and designs of Robert Holme Bowman, furniture maker, 1833-1852.

National Library of Wales, Aberystwyth

Thirty-six volumes of the diaries of John Cowper Powys, 1930-1961.

Papers of Eliot Crawshay-Williams (1879-1962), politician and author.

Cambridge University Library

An important collection of books, including a few medieval manuscripts, mainly 15th century, from the estate of the distinguished hispanist and former deputy librarian, F J Norton, were acquired this summer. The manuscripts, which have not yet been accessioned, include vernacular texts in French and Spanish, and classical texts in humanist script.

NATIONAL HERITAGE MEMORIAL FUND (NHMF)

In the current financial year, 1986-87, the Fund has sustained its excellent record of support for the conservation and acquisition of manuscripts and archives. Payments for conservation include a final instalment for the Bedford College archives (£293), and continuing payments to the British Theatre Association Library (£413) and the Royal Institute of Architects in Scotland (£471). Grants

for acquisitions to date have been to the National Library of Scotland, the Murthly Hours (£395,000); the National Library of Wales, proof of a Saxton map of Wales, c 1580 (£53,900); the British Library, papers of Richard Graham, 1st Viscount Preston (£40,000); British Architectural Library, Cockerell Papers (£4,603).

PURCHASE FUND GRANT, VICTORIA AND ALBERT MUSEUM

The Fund, administered by the V & A and designed to help repositories not directly funded by the Government, has contributed to the purchase of the following manuscript material: 'The story of Rimini' by Leigh Hunt (Keats House, Camden Arts and Libraries); Orlebar MSS (Bedford County Record Office); documents concerning De Quincey and the Wordsworths (Dove Cottage, Grasmere); architectural drawings by C R Cockerell, c 1825 (RIBA, London); Cecil/Maxse Papers (Bodleian Library, Oxford); 'Sylvia's Lovers' by Mrs Gaskell, English verses by Robert Barnes, 17th century, literary manuscript of John Fountain and Jacob Kramer letters (Brotherton Library, Leeds University); John Keble letters (Hampshire County Record Office, Winchester); letter and poems by John Clare (Northampton Central Library); travel diary of Letitia Hawkins, 1821-24 (Richmond Central Reference Library, Surrey).

COMITÉ INTERNATIONAL DE PALÉOGRAPHIE LATINE

Among new members elected to the Comité are A C de la Mare and Malcolm Parkes. Other new members are Virginia Brown, Emanuele Casamassima, Pierre Gasnault, Monica Hedlung, Denis Muzerelle, Herad Spilling, Paola Supino Martini. It is planned to hold the next plenary session in Madrid in September 1987.

THE BRITISH LIBRARY

Following the re-organization of the Department of Manuscripts, Map Library, Music Library and Philatelic collections into a Department of Special Collections, as announced in NL 13, Mrs Sarah Tyacke, formerly of the Map Library, has been appointed Director of Special Collections. T A J Burnett has been appointed Deputy Director in charge of cataloguing in the Department of Manuscripts.

NATIONAL LIBRARY OF WALES

A new manuscript reading room was opened in September 1986. It was created by the in-fill of a courtyard, has natural light from above and places for 30 readers.

LOCATION REGISTER OF TWENTIETH-CENTURY ENGLISH LITERARY MANUSCRIPTS AND LETTERS

The 1985-86 annual report has been circulated. Copies are obtainable from Dr David Sutton, The Library, University of Reading. British Library Publications will produce the register as a two-volume book in 1988. The possibility is being explored of establishing an on-line computer service in the 1990s, and of extending the scope of the register to holdings of English literary manuscripts, 1700-1900, in libraries in Great Britain and Ireland.

INDEX OF ENGLISH LITERARY MANUSCRIPTS

Following the publication in 1980 of volume I of the Index, parts 1 and 2 for

1450-1625, Mansell Ltd have now produced volume III, 1700-1800, part 1, A-F, compiled by M M Smith, and volume IV, 1800-1900, part 1, A-G, compiled by B Rosenbaum and P White.

A REGISTER OF WRITTEN SOURCES USED BY AUTHORS IN ANGLO-SAXON ENGLAND

Following public meetings at King's College, London, in March 1986 and at the Kalamazoo Conference in May 1986, an executive committee has been set up to organize the production of a corpus of all written sources which were incorporated, quoted, translated or adapted in texts composed in Latin or English in Anglo-Saxon England. Director of the scheme is Professor P A M Clemons (Cambridge); General Secretary, Dr J M Hill (Leeds); Secretary for Old English, Dr D G Scragg (Manchester), and for Latin Dr M Lapidge (Cambridge). Contributions will be stored on computer at Manchester University, but will eventually be published in book form. Liaison is maintained with two complementary projects: the revision of Ogilvy's Books known to the English, to be edited by Professors P E Szarmach, T D Hill and T W Mackay, and the list of extant manuscripts written or owned in England up to 1100 being produced by Professor H Gneuss (Munich).

PHILIP LARKIN MEMORIAL APPEAL FUND

Philip Larkin died on 2 December 1985. This appeal is to establish a fund in his memory to help the libraries of Great Britain and Ireland to buy modern literary manuscripts, and also to help to endow a Philip Larkin room in the library of the University of Hull. THE MURTHLY HOURS APPEAL FUND

The National Library of Scotland has successfully appealed for funds to buy this magnificent illuminated book of hours of c 1310 with medieval Scottish connexions. The manuscript, which has been in the Bute family since 1887, was offered for sale at £550,000, of which £395,000 was contributed by the National Heritage Memorial Fund.

NEIL KER MEMORIAL FUND

The object of this fund, recently established by the family and friends of Neil R Ker (1908-82), is to promote the study of western medieval manuscripts - and in particular those of British interest - by means of awards in support of all aspects of research, including travel and publication, made to both younger and established scholars of any nationality. It is hoped in the first instance to make up to four annual awards of about £500 each. Applications can be made on forms obtainable from the British Academy, 20 Cornwall Terrace, London NW1. The closing date will be 31 December each year (later applications accepted for 1986) and applicants will be notified of the outcome approximately three months later.

MANUSCRIPTS IN MICROFORM

Chadwyck-Healey Limited has published the Catalogue of Manuscripts in the Houghton Library, Harvard University, an 8 volume printed edition of the card catalogue and a microfiche edition of the typescript inventories. As most readers will know, the National Inventory of Documentary Sources in the United Kingdom began last year. Appearing in 8 units per year (minimum £750 per unit), it is not possible to purchase selected parts. Also from Chadwyck-Healey comes the John Muir Papers 1858-1942 (51 reels plus 53 fiches, \$3,250). [Muir (d 1914) was a prominent American conservationist.]

Harvester's expanding literary list, British Literary Heritage, includes: The Early and Central Middle Ages, c 650-1200 AD: the manuscript record, parts 1 and 2, manuscripts from Cambridge University Library (£500 and £780); British literary manuscripts from the British Library ... Series 1, The English Renaissance ... c 1500-c 1700, parts 1-4 (approx £900 per part); British literary manuscripts from the Folger Shakespeare Library ... The English Renaissance ... c 1500-c 1700, part 1 (£750); The Forster and Dyce Collections from the National Art Library at the Victoria and Albert Museum, London, Part 1, 16th- and 17th-century manuscripts (£700); The European Romantic Tradition: The Sir Walter Scott manuscripts, part 1 (£1,150) and The Rudyard Kipling papers, part 1, Journalism and literary papers ... from the University of Sussex Library and Cambridge University Library (£450).

Inter Documentation Company AG have made available on microfiche Arabic Manuscripts in the School of Oriental and African Studies, University of London, (1,569 fiches, Sfr 6,200, individual manuscripts available separately) and Arabic Manuscripts in the Jewish and National University Library of Jerusalem (Sfr 17,500). Other IDC releases are Conference of British Missionary Societies archives 1912-54 (4,990 fiches, Sfr 17,960); United Society for Christian Literature Archives, 1799-1960 (3,675 microfiches, Sfr 13,230); and Yale Divinity School: finding aids to archives and manuscript collections (31 fiches, Sfr 204).

Library of Congress Photoduplication Service have made a microfilm of the National American Woman Suffrage Association Records (73 reels, \$1,675).

Microform Limited (formerly E P Microform et al) of East Ardsley, Yorkshire, have produced a microfilm edition of American Papers in the House of Lords Record Office. A printed calendar and index edited by W Minchinton and P Harper is available separately. This elusive work apparently was published in 1983.

Other collections from this publisher in variant guises not noted previously include William Wilberforce Papers, Papers of Sir Frederick Maze, and the Mackinnon Papers, the last two from the School of Oriental and African Studies.

An interesting set from Research Publications Inc is the Papers of Panton, Leslie and Company, Florida merchants, who from 1783 established a virtual monopoly in the Indian trade from St Augustine to Memphis, besides becoming a leading supplier to Spanish settlers. The set will reproduce the 'most pertinent' material from originals and copies collected in the Americas and Europe by a team based at the University of West Florida, Pensacola (c 40 reels, due late 1986).

World Microfilms Publications have published the second part of the Collection of Mediaeval and Renaissance manuscripts at Trinity College Dublin. Entitled 'Secular studies', it consists of four sections - Music, Law, Heraldry and genealogy, and General - each available separately, or together for £1,295. Mediaeval Renaissance manuscript collections at Oxford Colleges, Section 3, Theology: General and Patristics, part one, Christ Church (25 reels, £575) and Merton (51 reels, £1,195) is now available, as is the Worshipful Company of Pewterers records, registers and reports 1451-1934 (32 reels, £850). They also announce a North American slave trade set, the Heartman Manuscript Collection at Xavier University Library, New Orleans: manuscripts on slavery covering 1724-1897 (7 reels, £175; or c 200 fiches, £225).

The proceedings of the 2nd Congresso di Storia della Miniatura Italiana held at Cortona on 24-26 September 1982 have been published as no 6 of the series Storia della Miniatura. Studi e Documenti, ed E Sesti (1985). Contributors include M Paoli, J J G Alexander, A C de la Mare, G D Regoli, P T Grandi, G M Canova, G Castiglioni, H J Eberhardt and M Levi d'Ancona.

The Netherlands Yearbook for History of Art, Deel 36, for 1985, is devoted to articles on medieval manuscripts.
